### Cases

In each case below, you are given a situation and several possible answers. You are to decide which answers are correct. **There may be multiple correct answers for each case.** In all cases, R = the receiving team, K = the kicking team, A = the offensive team, and B = the defensive team.

1. Which of the following is true regarding a conference?
  - a) A conference is limited to eleven players per team, when the conference is held on the sideline in front of the team box.
  - b) A conference is limited to eleven players per team, when the conference is held on the field between the hash marks.
  - c) Any number of coaches can meet with the players when the conference is held between the hash marks.
  - d) Any number of coaches may meet with the players when the conference is held near the sideline.
  - e) All of the above.
  - f) None of the above.
  
2. Which of the following is true regarding the ball?
  - a) The ball shall be tan in color and approximately 12 inches long.
  - b) The ball shall have eight or ten evenly spaced laces.
  - c) The ball shall have a white stripe approximately 3 inches from the end of the ball that goes completely around the ball.
  - d) The ball shall weigh no more than 16 ounces.
  - e) The ball shall be inflated to no more than 16 PSI.
  - f) Each team must provide at least two game balls for approval before the game.
  - g) The umpire shall decide whether the ball meets specifications.
  - h) All of the above.
  - i) None of the above.
  
3. Which of the following is true regarding the game equipment?
  - a) A kicking tee may be used that does not elevate the lowest point of the ball more than three inches above the ground.

- b) The line to gain equipment can be a yardage chain joining two rods that are exactly 10 yards apart.
  - c) The line to gain equipment will be operated approximately one yard outside the sideline opposite the press box.
  - d) Each player must wear a helmet secured by a properly fastened chinstrap with at least two attachment points.
  - e) Each player must wear a jersey with a clearly visible and legible Arabic number 00 thru 99 inclusive on the front and back.
  - f) The jersey must cover all of the shoulder pads and all hard surface auxiliary attachments.

4. Which of the following is true about player equipment?
- a) Each player must wear pants which cover the knees, thigh guards, knee pads, and any portion of any knee brace that does not extend below the pants.
  - b) Each player must wear shoes, which may have removable or non-removable cleats.
  - c) A player may wear forearm pads which may be anchored on each end by athletic tape if sanctioned by the referee.
  - d) A player can wear a tinted eye shield if his head coach or trainer presents a letter from a licensed medical physician to the referee before the game.
  - e) A player can play with a hard cast on his/her hand or arm if it is properly padded with closed cell, slow recovery foam padding no less than ½” thick.
